Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Develop confidence & independence.
Form positive relationships with peers & adults.
Play co-operatively, sharing & taking turns with others.
Develop respect for each other and their environment.
Understand & follow rules, routine & boundaries.
Be aware of own & others feelings.

Communication & Language

Speak clearly with confidence.
Interact with others through communication.
Maintain attention & concentration.
Question why things happen.
Extend vocabulary by grouping & naming, explore the meaning of new words.

Physical Development

Recognise the factors & importance of a healthy lifestyle.
Manage own basic hygiene & personal needs.
Use a varied range of small & large equipment.
Handle tools with safety & control.
Develop hand/eye co-ordination.
Move with control & spatial awareness.

Literacy

Attempt to write for a purpose-using a pencil effectively. Begin to write own name in the form of recognisable letters.
Develop a phonological awareness within phase 1. Link sounds & letters- (naming and sounding/blending letters of the alphabet).
Listen to & join in with stories with increasing attention & recall.
Recognise familiar words & signs.
Handle & enjoy books independently.

Mathematics

Count & identify numbers 0-20 & beyond.
Use appropriate mathematical language.
Recognise colour, shape & pattern.
Develop ideas & methods to problem solve.
To organise & categorise objects.
Understand how to weigh, compare, measure & balance.
Begin to understand simple addition/subtraction using objects.

Understanding the World

Investigate & observe objects & materials.
Build & construct using a wide range of objects.
Find out & identify the uses of ICT/Technology.
Recognise the similarities & differences between themselves & others and among families, communities & traditions.
Ask questions & talk about how & why things work.
Show an understanding of growth, decay & changes over time.

Expressive Arts & Design

Explore & experiment with colour, texture & shape.
Use imagination in art, music & role play.
Recognise sound & sound patterns.
Create constructions, collages, paintings & drawings.
Sing simple songs from memory.
Represent their own ideas thoughts & feelings through role play, art, stories, music & dance.
